#### Where we have been:

We have completed Topic 2: Addition Strategies as well as Topic 3: Subtraction Strategies. Both helped to teach basic computation.

#### Where we are going:

Our class is currently working on Topic 4: Place Value to 100. We will also be starting Topic 5: Counting Money this month.

#### Ways to help your child at home:

\* practice math facts

\* skip count with your child (count by 2's 3's 5's)

\* have your child count extra change

#### Literacy

**Nightly Homework:** Thank you for all of your support with you child nightly baggy book! The skill for this month is visualization. You child needs to draw a picture of what they picture in their mind as they read.

**Comprehension Skills:** In October we will be focusing in these comprehension skills: context clues, problem and solution, and making inferences.

**Skill Groups:** Second grade has started skill groups that will help us meet the individual needs within the grade level! At conferences we can talk about which skill is being targeted for your child.

**Spelling Words:** Each spelling list is connected to the phonics skill for the week.

### Helping your child with spelling:

\* Have to child explain the skill to reinforce the

We are finishing up our study of plants this month. Your child has learned so many new things about plants including, the parts of a plant, each parts purpose, ways seed travel, different types of plant you can eat, and more!
